The BioTherapeutics, Education and Research Foundation

The BTER (pronounced "Better") Foundation was established in February, 2003, with the aim of improving the quality of, and access to, biotherapeutic medicine. Also known as symbiotic medicine, biotherapy is the use of live organisms to diagnose or treat diseases.

✓ What is Biotherapy?

- Maggot therapy (MDT)
- Hirudotherapy (leech therapy)
- Apitherapy (honeybee therapy)
- Ichtheotherapy (wound-debriding fish)
- Pet therapy & sniffer dogs

The diseases treated biotherapeutically are often serious, incapacitating, or even life-threatening: diabetic/neuropathic foot ulcers, chronic leg ulcers, pressure ulcers (bed sores), re-attachment of severed limbs, multiple sclerosis, rheumatoid arthritis, epilepsy, and more.

✓ Biotherapy is not the status quo

Biotherapy is not the status quo, which is why some insurance companies do not cover it, and why few medical programs teach it.

But when conventional therapy fails, doctors and patients often turn to biotherapy to save limbs and save lives.
